### Education sponsorship program

We celebrate having **275** children supported under our sponsorship program in 2023: - **9** at University

- **8** in Vocational programs
- **103** in Secondary school
- **155** in Primary school

Six students completed O-Level and ten completed A-Level exams, preparing to begin university.

# I AM Academy

I AM Academy in Wabinyira enrolled **283 students** this year, including **70 fully sponsored**. A new classroom block was completed, offering a better learning environment.

Current needs include desks, dormitory completion, and additional teaching materials.

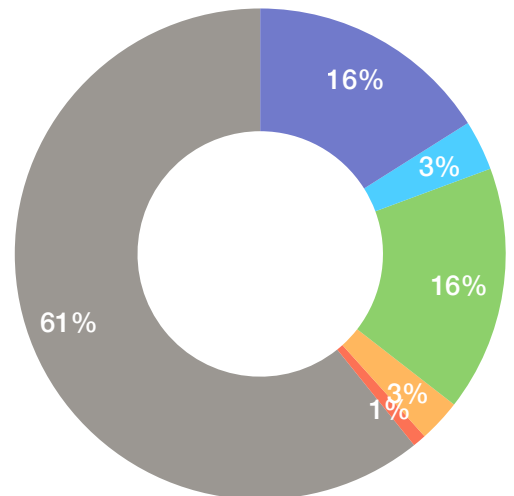

## Where We Work

We serve in **UGANDA and RWANDA**, reaching communities with Christ-centered education, discipleship, and holistic empowerment. Our ministry operates **three centers in Uganda** and **one center in Rwanda**, each uniquely positioned to support vulnerable children and families.

### OUR PRESENCE IN UGANDA

We serve across three primary centers: - **Kampala Center** – Home to administration, church ministry, and choir training, serving urban communities through discipleship, youth outreach, and family support. - **Wabinyira Village Center (Mityana District)** – Home of I AM Academy, agricultural programs, women empowerment initiatives, and children's discipleship activities. - **Community Outreach Hub** – Focused on rural support, family strengthening, and local discipleship through schools, churches, and community groups.

These centers work together to deliver education, healthcare support, emotional care, spiritual formation, and skills development for long-term transformation.

## OUR PRESENCE IN RWANDA

Our Rwanda center offers Christian discipleship, family outreach, youth programs, and support to vulnerable families. The team works closely with local churches to equip young people spiritually and academically while fostering leadership grounded in biblical values.

## IMPACT HIGHLIGHTS

- Over **400+ children and youth** supported across both countries.
- Discipleship clubs established to nurture spiritual growth.
- Women's empowerment programs training mothers and caregivers.
- Agricultural development increasing family resilience.
