

We are happy to share that **275 children** are enrolled in our sponsorship program, and we continue to seek more sponsors to help these children reach their dreams.

HIGHLIGHTS FROM
SPONSORSHIP & SOCIAL WORK
DEPARTMENT

Our social work team maintained close contact with all sponsored children, ensuring regular writing of term letters and monitoring academic performance.

However, we faced challenges: - We sadly lost **Precious Nazire** (11 years) on **29th March 2024**, a pupil at Nakulabye Junior School. - **15 children** dropped out of the program: - 8 relocated - 7 were dropped due to sponsor financial hardship

We organized **three Center Days**—two at I AM Academy Wabinyira and one at the I AM Family Ministries offices in Lungujja—featuring:

- Career guidance - Fun games and sports - First aid & road safety training - Arts & crafts innovation with banana fiber doll-and ball-making

We also held **two Focus Career** Days for **S.4, S.6**, and **vacation students**.

I AM ACADEMY SCHOOL

I AM Academy has continued to flourish, with **302 students enrolled in 2024** (166 boys and 136 girls). Of these, **85 students** are sponsored and **7 are in high school.** Our team includes **12 trained teachers** and **one U.S. volunteer, Shanna Faith**, who supported home visits, Bible devotions, literacy, and sports.

ACHIEVEMENTS

- 12 P7 candidates completed their Primary Leaving Examinations.
- A thanksgiving prayer day was held in their honor, led by Ps. Daniel Mugerwa.
- **38 children graduated** from pre-school to Primary One, celebrating their milestone in colorful gowns.

STRATEGIC DEVELOPMENT

Dormitory/Choir house construction continues and is expected to be completed in **2025**. Support is needed for: - Sponsorships - Furniture & school supplies - Reading books - Uniforms - Medical care - Sports & games - Playground development



SUCCESSFUL GRADUATION ACHIEVEMENTS



Our students continued to excel at tertiary and university levels.



Samuel Akandwanaho graduated with a Bachelor's Degree in Law from Uganda Christian University and has enrolled in LDC to become a certified lawyer.

Cinderella Kemirembe completed a Certificate in Electrical Installation Systems & Maintenance with 4.02 points and is upgrading to a Diploma in Electrical & Electronics Engineering at UICT.





Muhoozi Victor graduated with a **Diploma** in **Clinical Medicine** from Clerk International University.

I AM FAMILY NEXT GENERATION CHOIR

The new Next Generation Choir was launched in preparation for the Arise & Shine 2025 Tour. Auditions and registration at I AM Academy resulted in 40 children joining the program. Training has begun and online booking for tour shows is underway.



SPIRITUAL GROWTH

I AM Family Church continued to grow spiritually and numerically: - 230+ weekly attendance - 61 new converts during church services - 65 new converts during Street Praise Evangelism - 155 new converts during CFAN Crusades in July

The church also conducted training for Sunday school teachers, school teachers, and youth leaders, facilitated by **One Hope Ministries**, who provided ministry tools, teaching manuals, and student materials.







USA SPONSORSHIP UPDATES 2024

A total of **199 children** were supported through the USA sponsorship program in 2024 across all centers.

This represents approximately **72%** of all children supported under I AM Family Ministries, demonstrating the continued strength and commitment of our global partners.

The USA sponsorships played a major role in ensuring access to education, healthcare, and discipleship support for children in Lungujja, Wabinyira, Busega, and Rwanda.
